Re: Request for access to records under the Kansas Open Records Act

This letter is a request from the KPA Sentinel, 5423 S.W. 7<sup>th</sup>, Topeka, KS 66606 for access to records of the Anytown Board of Education relating to its involvement with the Schools for Fair Funding organization. Specifically, we request access to all invoices involving payment of dues, expense reimbursements, lobbying expenses or any other payments made by the Anytown Board of Education from the date of first payment to SFFF until today, Jan. 1, 2008.

As you are well aware, it is the public policy of the state of Kansas that “public records shall be open for inspection by any person unless otherwise provided by this act, and this act shall be liberally construed and applied to promote such policy.”

Please indicate to the KPA Sentinel the approximate cost of meeting this open records request, both for copies and for any staff time that might be required to complete the request. K.S.A. 45-219 defines a reasonable charge for copies as equal to or less than \$.25 per page.

We also request that the KPA Sentinel be provided the requested documents in a timely fashion, certainly within the three business days required by K.S.A. 45-218, and that should our request be denied, that you provide a written statement to us of the grounds for denial.
